A VERY GOOD, PURE, AND CLEAN STYLE OF BLUEBERRY WINE WITH A LOT OF FRESHNESS

Visual

Clear and bright with a moderate ruby core and light purple rim, dense legs, no CO₂ or sediment, a developing appearance.

Nose

Clean and fragrant dominated by fresh, ripe dark blueberries, cherries and blackberries, hint of cherry blossom, aeration reveals sweet blueberry jam notes and touch of aromatic herbs, still youthful delivering lots of freshness.

Palate

Clean and dry with a moderate structure and a very clean and refreshing acidity complemented by very fine tannin, mid-palate is juicy and very pure with fresh red cherries, plums and crunchy red apple, really well balanced, crisp and fresh with a light complexity.

Conclusions

Very good quality Black currant wine with great concentration, balance and purity.

Ageing potential Next 1-3 years.

Food pairing

Light appetizers, cold cuts, poultry dishes, medium aged cheese, pasta with tomato. Slightly chilled with fatty fish like tuna, salmon.

Serve slightly chilled 12-14 C° from a narrow red wine glass to underline the fruit character, freshness and the really fragrant nose..

Commercial appeal

Could be interesting for restaurants serving local produce. As it is a dry expression of blueberries, could be appealing for guests who like lighter style dry red wines.
