A GOOD QUALITY OFF DRY ROWAN BERRY WINE
WITH FRESHNESS, BALANCE AND PURITY

Visual

Brilliant amber colour with light coppery reflections, oily legs and no visual CO₂ or sediment, a developing appearance

Nose

Clean and fragrant nose with appealing rowan berry scents, pickled rowans complemented by earthy notes and resin flavours, just a hint of honey and cloudberry jam, moderate complexity and still developing.

Palate

Clean and off dry with a good bite and good sense of freshness, crisp acidity and mild alcohol, mid-palate is juicy with moderate flavour intensity packed with crunchy rowan berry notes, pickled rowan berries, notes of resin and mild spices, scent of cloudberry and honey finished off with a pleasant rowan astringency and bitterness.

Conclusions

A good quality off dry rowan berry wine with freshness, balance and purity.

Ageing potential

Next 1-3 years.

Food pairing

Autumn root vegetable stew with chicken, soft kind of cheese served with a rowan berry chutney.

Serve chilled 8-10 C° from a sleek dessert wine glass to underline the rowan berry character.

Commercial appeal

Commercial appeal: Because of its specific character (rowan) this wine could be interesting for limited audience and restaurants focusing on local Baltic/Scandinavian style of cuisine.
